- Meet with a PACE counselor We'll reach out to you after you submit your application to discuss your goals, including transferring to a university, and will help you build an educational plan.
 Important - Make sure to send all official transcripts from other colleges to DVC prior to scheduling your counseling appointment so we can plan around your previous coursework.
- 4. Complete your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) Yes! You may qualify for a need-based tuition waiver or our program for first-time, full-time students. www.dvc.edu/financialaid

What is an Associate Degree for Transfer?

A transfer degree can guarantee admission to the CSU system, and comes with other perks, like junior standing if you transfer into a similar program, and sometimes even a GPA boost if you are applying to a competitive school.

How much does PACE cost?

DVC is very affordable at only \$46 per unit for California residents (about \$1,380 per year for a full-time, 12-unit course load).

Are PACE students eligible for DVC's free tuition program?

Yes! You may qualify for a need-based tuition waiver or our program for first-time, full-time students.
